The sale will be held at the Michigan State University Pavilion for Agriculture and Livestock Education in Lansing, MI.

MSBA is offering you an opportunity to market your Shorthorn and Shorthorn Plus (any percentage) consignments at this event. We encourage you to consign your bulls, bred females, and open heifers to this event. Semen, embryo and flush opportunities are welcome. Early interest in this Shorthorn and Shorthorn composite sale is strong. Please keep in mind, the Beef Expo is also offering a "pen" sale opportunity for cattle that you are not interested in showing. Pens of up to 1 to 3 heifers/bred females are available.

Changes in the format over the last couple of years have made it even easier for potential buyers to participate. The committee is committed to stronger regional and national advertising and has also contracted to post all breed sales online as well as the catalog. This gives us a much stronger opportunity to reach buyers outside of Michigan. We encourage you to forward the very best photos of your consignments, their sire or dam as the catalog will be printed in full color. Only the best quality photos will be considered for printing. Additionally, if you have an opportunity to take video, this can be shared on the MSBA and MCA Facebook pages. Videos can also be posted for view by buyers online.

It is the Association's policy that all consignors be current members of the MSBA. Consignments have complete genetic testing, unless in the case of "free by pedigree". Testing takes several weeks, if you do not have test results back prior to sale time that information will be announced from the sale block. It is the Association's expectation that you have sent samples and paid for the testing on all consignments in the sale. Results for Sire and Dam that are posted on the ASA website will be made available at the time of sale. We encourage you to review all MCA sale consignment guidelines enclosed with this mailing regarding health and BSE requirements.

## **Important information for sale cattle consignors and owners of display cattle at the 2022 MI Beef Expo**

**HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:** Please refer to the current requirements for Livestock exhibited in Michigan at [www.michigan.gov/mda-exhibitinfo](http://www.michigan.gov/mda-exhibitinfo).

**OUT OF STATE CATTLE:** All cattle from out of state must have interstate travel papers. Please contact the Michigan Dept. of Agriculture Animal Industry Division at **800-292-3939** for details about these requirements.

**BREEDING SOUNDNESS EXAMS:** All bulls born prior to March 1, 2021 must have a complete breeding soundness exam (BSE) as defined by the Society for Theriogenology. Bulls not passing the BSE will not be eligible for sale. All bulls born between March 1, 2021 and April 30, 2021 will be subject to meeting all requirements of a BSE, except they will only need 50% morphologically normal sperm to pass (as compared to 70% for bulls born prior to March 1, 2021). A list of Michigan veterinarians who provide Bull Breeding Soundness Examination services is available at [www.MICattlemen.org](http://www.MICattlemen.org). BSE's will NOT be provided on-site.

**BOVINE VIRAL DIARRHEA (BVD) TEST:** All sale cattle must provide negative test results and documentation for BVD and provide to the sale chairperson/s at check-in time.

**RING & BUG:** All display and sale bulls (any age) must have a ring or bug in their nose when out of the stall at the Beef Expo.

**TIE OUTS:** All animals must be double tied while in tie outs.

**MEMBERSHIP:** All sale consignors must be regular Michigan Cattlemen's Association members.

**RFID TAGS:** All cattle at the Michigan Beef Expo are required to have RFID ear tags. Tags will be available on site for out of state cattle at a cost of \$2.00 each.

**CATTLE ARRIVAL:** Sale and exhibit cattle may arrive beginning Thursday after 8:00 am. For out of state exhibitors, if early arrival is necessary, please contact Scott Rancour at the MSU Pavilion, 517-432-5566. Set up of stalling areas may be done on Wednesday between 3:00 p.m. and 7:30 p.m. Doors will be locked at 8:00 p.m.

**LIVESTOCK JUDGING CONTEST:** Consignors are required to allow for their cattle to be used for the Livestock Judging Contest if requested.

**CATTLE DISPLAY AREA:** Take the opportunity to make your cattle display exhibit as attractive as possible. Please be respectful of other exhibitors and guests and keep the aisles clean and keep your possessions within your assigned space. Remember, no grooming chutes are permitted in the display area. **If you sprinkle your bedding with water, please use a limited amount so that it does not flow into adjacent exhibitor spaces.**

**TRADE SHOW EXHIBITORS:** Be sure to visit the Trade Show exhibitors and let them know how much you appreciate their support. They are a vital part of the success of Michigan Beef Expo. Trade show will be open Friday 11:00 p.m. - 8:00 p.m. and Saturday 9:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.

**TENTATIVE SALE SCHEDULE:** 11:00 a.m. start time

**HEIFER PENS:** Consignors may enter up to three (3) REGISTERED, non-HALTERED **females**. These cattle will not be shown in their respective breed show. The consignor must provide certificates of registration from a United States breed registry. Cattle will be penned in a designated area of the MSU Pavilion.
