

MSBA BoD Meeting
June 15, 2025, 7 p.m., Via Zoom

Board members present: Tara Miller, Stacy Stinson, Trish Steele, Carla McLachlan, Megan Bosserd, Cami Marz-Evans and Anne Pease

The meeting was called to order at 7:10 p.m. by Tara Miller, president.

The secretary's report was presented. Stacy Stinson made a motion to approve the minutes as presented, supported by Carla McLachlan. Motion carried.

The treasurer's report was presented. The checking account balance is \$353.28. The savings account balance was \$1,395.13 and the balance in the CD account was \$11,078.70. Carla McLachlan made a motion to accept the treasurer's report as presented, supported by Stacy Stinson and passed.
